**Race Comments:** Before an estimated crowd of 75,000 Bobby Labonte won the Aaron's 312, his 10th career NASCAR Busch Series victory and his first since Darlington in March 1998. Prior to the green flag the following driver dropped to the rear for the reason indicated: # 22 Bliss (unapproved impound adjustment). The 36 lead changes set a new series record. The 20 different leaders set the record for the most leaders in a NASCAR Busch Series race at Talladega.
